Directions to Robert Menzies College

Parking at the conference venue is extremely limited and preference will be given to those staying onsite or visiting to present workshops. As other free parking options in the area are scarce, you are **strongly encouraged to use public transport** (train station and bus stops are close by) to and from the venue. If you have a special need for parking e.g. disability, bringing a group of conference attendees, or no public transport option, please [email](#) for a permit which may be provided on a priority basis.

There are several ways of reaching RMC if you are not driving. Please see below for your personal preference.
Robert Menzies College address: 136 Herring Road North Ryde.

Train: The Macquarie University train station is just 50 metres from RMC. Regular services direct to the city are available. It takes roughly 20 – 30 minutes.

Buses: to the City use the Buses No: 288 & 290. It takes roughly 30 minutes.

Taxis: can be contacted on 9581 1111 in the Sydney area.

Arriving at RMC from Sydney Airport

▶ Take the train from either international terminal or domestic terminal to Central station; change trains at Central and select the train to Macquarie University via Chatswood. (Northern Line N1) When you arrive at Macquarie University station, take the elevator to street level. Cross the road to the corner which has the tall red sign with “Macquarie University” on it. This is the corner where RMC is situated.

▶ Quickest but most expensive is to take a taxi: approximate cost is around \$70 - \$85AUD depending on the time of day and the traffic conditions.

▶ Take an airport shuttle bus from either domestic or international terminals to Central Station. Change trains at Central and select the train to Macquarie University via Chatswood. When you arrive at Macquarie University station, take the elevator to street level. Cross the road to the corner which has the tall red sign with “Macquarie University” on it. This is the corner where RMC is situated.
