Mission Seek is a database which connects enquirers and agencies, allowing enquirers to easily investigate mission and service opportunities in a wide range of agencies, all in one accessible place.

Missions Interlink now offers all its Member and Associate organisations the opportunity to be a part of this growing database by including Mission Seek Basic Partnership subscription in the annual membership fee.

Mission Seek Basic Partnership includes:

- 1. Registration as a Mission Seek partner** with a brief description of your organisation, contact details, and link to your website.
- 2. A Vacancies section** where you can advertise up to 5 opportunities. You will be able to directly list and update your personnel needs in the database. These can be paid or unpaid, part time or full time, within Australia or overseas and you are able to update these as often as you like.
- 3. A Short Term Teams section** where you can enter details of your upcoming short term teams and update as needed.
- 4. Promotion of your opportunities through Mission Seek** at mission expos and events where Missions Interlink is present.
- 5. Wider Exposure for your Organisation:** Mission Seek provides your organisation the opportunity for exposure to individuals who may not know of your specific ministry but who find it listed on the database during the course of their investigations.
- 6. Training** in the use of the software and support by the Mission Seek Administrator so you can manage your listings on the database.
